PREAMBLE

Ethanol Blended Petrol programme (EBP) was launched by the government in 2003 to promote the use of alternative and environment friendly fuels. This intervention also seeks to reduce import dependence for energy requirements and give boost to agriculture sector. Government has notified the National Bio-fuel Policy according to which 10% blending of ethanol into petrol has been targeted through various feed stocks other than the conventional route. The government initiatives and policies have significantly improved the supply of ethanol during the past four years. In the present scenario, production of ethanol through direct sugarcane juice or through 'B' heavy molasses is not only a profitable proposition but this will also sap the excess sugar production to maintain balance in sugar production. However, to meet the desired blending target in future with the ever increasing requirement of auto mobile fuels, there is need for developing alternative feed stocks.
