G.S.R. .- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, and in the supersession of National Sugar Institute, Kanpur, Professor (Sugar Engineering), Assistant Professor(Sugar Engineering), Lecturer(Sugar Engineering), Assistant Engineer (Electrical / Mechanical Engineering) and Senior Research Assistant (Mechanical Engineering) Recruitment Rules, 2017 and Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distributions, Department of Food and Public Distribution, National Sugar Institute, Kanpur Chief Designer and Senior Draughtsman(Group 'A' and 'B' posts) Recruitment Rules, 2018 in so far they relate to the post of Professor (Sugar Engineering), Assistant Professor(Sugar Engineering), Lecturer(Sugar Engineering), Assistant Engineer (Electrical) / Assistant Engineer (Mechanical) and Chief Designer respectively except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the president hereby makes the following rules to amend the National Sugar Institute, Kanpur Professor (Sugar Engineering), Assistant Professor(Sugar Engineering), Lecturer(Sugar Engineering), Assistant Engineer (Electrical) / Assistant Engineer (Mechanical) and Chief Designer in National Sugar Institute, Kanpur under the Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distributions, Department of Food and Public Distribution, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement.- (1) These rules may be called the National Sugar Institute, Kanpur, Professor (Sugar Engineering), Assistant Professor(Sugar Engineering), Lecturer(Sugar Engineering), Assistant Engineer (Electrical) / Assistant Engineer (Mechanical), Chief Designer, Recruitment Rules, 2024.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of posts, classification and level in pay matrix.- The number of said post, its classification and level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications, etc.- The method of recruitment to the said post, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the aforesaid Schedule.

4. Disqualification. - No person,-

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt such person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax.-Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Savings.- Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, ex-servicemen and other categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
