NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 30th August, 2001

G.S.R. 635(E).—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, and in supersession of the National Sugar Institute, Kanpur (Group 'A' and 'B' posts) Recruitment Rules, 1964, in so far as these relate to the posts of Chief Design Engineer and Professor of Chemical Engineering, except as respect things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the posts of Chief Design Engineer and Professor of Chemical Engineering in the National Sugar Institute, Kanpur, under the Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food & Public Distribution, namely:—

1. Short title and commencement.— (1) These rules may be called the National Sugar Institute, Kanpur (Chief Design Engineer and Professor of Chemical Engineering) Recruitment Rules, 2001.
(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of posts, classification and scales of pay.— The number of posts, their classification and the scales of pay attached thereto, shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the aforesaid Schedule.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit, other qualifications etc.— The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts, shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the said Schedule.

4. Disqualification.— No person:
(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any other person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of these rules.

5. Power to relax.— Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may by order, and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving.— Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Ex-Servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

Note :- The crucial date for determining the age-limit shall be the closing date for receipt of applications from candidates in India (and not the closing date prescribed for those in Assam, Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram, Manipur, Nagaland, Tripura, Sikkim, Ladakh division of Jammu and Kashmir state, Lahaul and Spiti District of Pangi sub-division of Chamba district of Himachal Pradesh, Andaman and Nicobar Islands or Lakshadweep.)

Desirable:

- (i) Master's degree in Chemical Engineering from a recognised University/Institute or equivalent.
- (ii) Experience in sugar or allied industry.
- (iii) Published research papers in Chemical Engineering.

Note 1: Qualifications are relaxable at the discretion of the Union Public Service Commission in the case of candidates otherwise well qualified.

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Note 2: The qualification(s) regarding experience is/are relaxable at the discretion of the Union Public Service Commission in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes or Scheduled tribes if at any stage of selection, the Union Public Service Commission is of the opinion that sufficient number of candidates from these communities possessing the requisite experience are not likely to be available to fill up the vacancies reserved for them.

(b) possessing the educational qualifications and experience prescribed for direct recruits under column 8.

Note: Only officers belonging to Central/State/Union Territory Governments are eligible to be considered for appointment on absorption basis.

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(Period of deputation, including the period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organisation/department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed five years. The maximum age-limit for appointment by deputation shall be not exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of applications.)
