New Delhi, the 14th March, 1983

G.S.R. 279.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules further to amend the National Sugar Institute, Kanpur (Group A and Group B) posts Recruitment Rules, 1964, namely:—

1. (1) These rules may be called the National Sugar Institute, Kanpur (Group A and B posts) Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 1983

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the National Sugar Institute, Kanpur (Group A and Group B posts) Recruitment Rules, 1964, in the Schedule, for serial number 41 and the entries relating thereto the following serial number and the entries shall be substituted:—
