NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 19th May, 2008

G.S.R. 392(E).—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the National Sugar Institute, Kanpur (Group 'A' and Group 'B' posts) Recruitment Rules, 1964, in so far as they relate to the posts of Senior Technical Assistant (Sugar Technology), Junior Technical Officer (Sugar Technology), Assistant Professor (Sugar Technology), Professor (Sugar Technology), except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the posts of Senior Technical Assistant (Sugar Technology), Junior Technical Officer (Sugar Technology), Assistant Professor (Sugar Technology), Professor (Sugar Technology) in the Sugar Technology Division of National Sugar Institute, Kanpur under the Department of Food and Public Distribution, Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution:

1. Short title and commencement.—(1) These rules may be called the National Sugar Institute, Kanpur, Sugar Technology Division Recruitment Rules, 2008.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of posts, classification and scale of pay.—The number of the said posts, their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications, etc.—The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (14) of the said Schedule.

4. Disqualification.—No person

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with another person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax.—Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with Union Public Service Commission relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

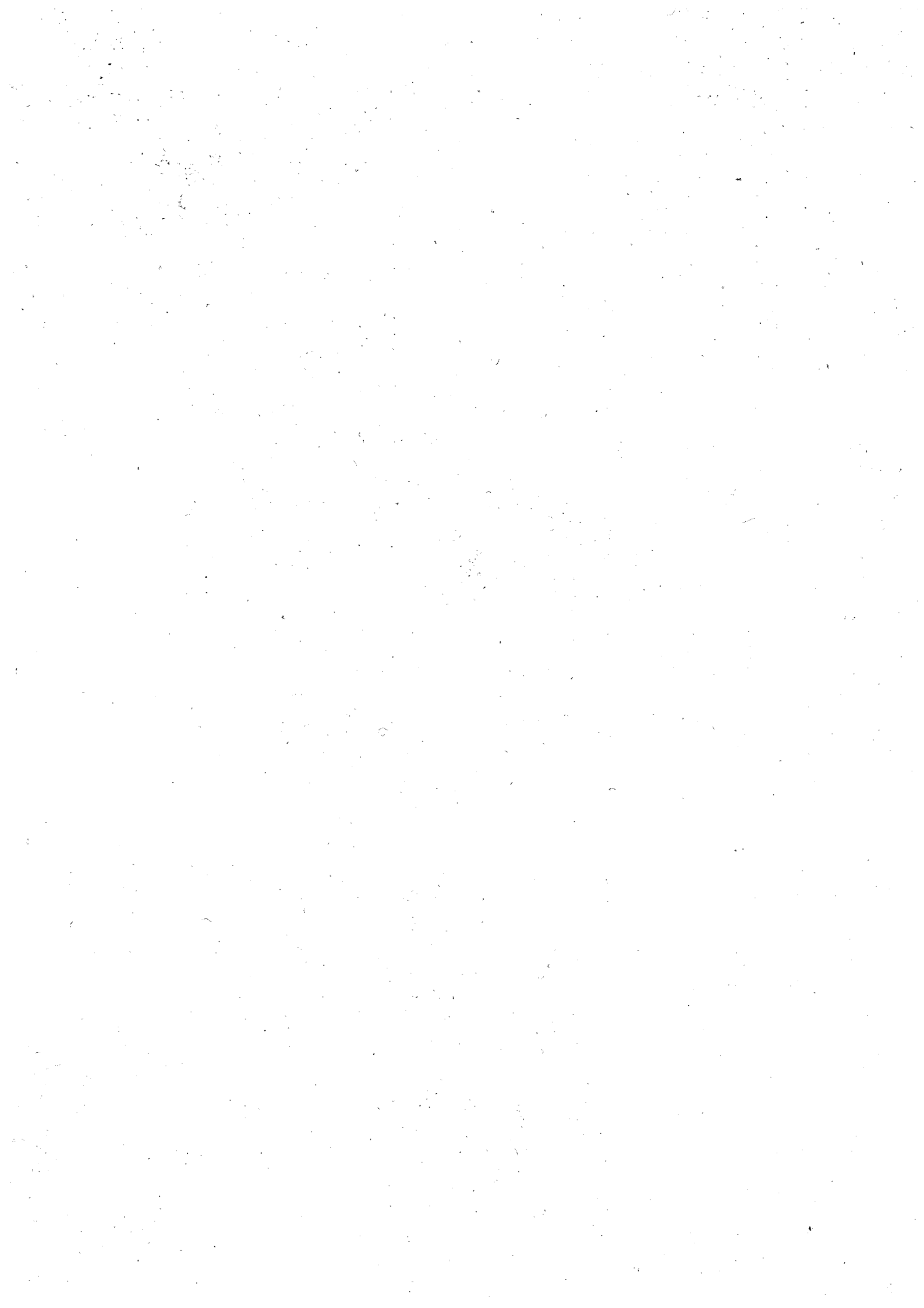
6. Saving.—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Ex-servicemen other backward classes, and other special categories of persons in accordance with the order issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

(ii) Teaching Experience.

Note 1. Qualifications are relaxable at the discretion of the Union Public Service Commission, for reasons to be recorded in writing, in the case of candidates otherwise well qualified.

Note 2. The qualification(s) regarding experience is/are relaxable at the discretion of the Union Public Service Commission, for reasons to be recorded in writing, in case of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes or Scheduled Tribes, if at any stage of selection, the Union Public Service Commission is of the opinion that sufficient number of candidates, possessing the requisite experience are not likely to be available to fill up the vacancies reserved for them.

Promotion

Technical Assistant (Sugar Technology) in the pay scale of Rs. 4,500-125-7,000 with 8 years regular service in the grade.

Note :—Where juniors, who have completed their qualifying/eligibility service are being considered for promotion, their seniors would also be considered provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying/eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying/eligibility service or two years, whichever is less, and have successfully completed their probation period for promotion to the next higher grade, along with their juniors, who have already completed such qualifying/eligibility service.

Deputation (Including Short-Term Contract)

Officers under the Central/State Government/ Union Territories/Universities/Recognised Research Institutions/Public Sector Undertaking/ Semi-Government/Statutory or Autonomous Organizations :—

(a)(i) holding analogous posts on regular basis in the parent Cadre/Department; Or

(ii) with three years service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in the pay scale of Rs. 5,000—8,000 or equivalent, in parent Cadre/Department; or
