### Notification

GSR... In exercise of the powers conferred by the  
proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the  
National Sugar Institute (Stenographer Grade III) Recruitment Rules,  
1981, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the  
method of recruitment to the post of Stenographer Grade-III in the  
Ministry of Food, National Sugar Institute, Kanpur, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement.-(1) These rules may be called the  
Ministry of Food, National Sugar Institute, Kanpur, Stenographer  
Grade-III Group 'C' Post Recruitment Rules, 1994.  
(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in  
the official Gazette.
2. Number, classification and scale of pay.- The number of post,  
its classification and scale of pay attached thereto shall be  
as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed to these  
rules.
3. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualification, etc.-  
The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit, qualifica-  
tion and other matters relating thereto, shall be as specified in  
columns 5 to 14 of the said Schedule.
4. Disqualification:- No person,  
a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a  
person having a spouse (living) or  
b) who having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted  
a marriage with any person,  
shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that  
such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to  
such person and other party to the marriage and there are other  
grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this  
rule.

5. Power to relax.— Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, on reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
6. Savings.— Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions, required or provided for the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Ex-Servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
