NOTIFICATION

G.S.R..... In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules further to amend the National Sugar Institute, Kanpur (Group 'A' and Group 'B' Posts) Recruitment Rules, 1964, namely:-

1. (1) These rules may be called the National Sugar Institute, Kanpur (Group 'A' and Group 'B' Posts) Recruitment (Second Amendment) Rules, 1964.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Schedule to the National Sugar Institute, Kanpur (Group 'A' and Group 'B' Posts) Recruitment Rules, 1964, in serial number 50, for the entries relating to the post of Welfare-cum-Security Officer, the following entries shall be substituted, namely:-

The departmental officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation.

Similarly, deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

(Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organisation/department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not to exceed 3 (three) years. The maximum age limit for appointment by transfer on deputation shall be, not exceeding 56 years, as on the closing date of receipt of applications.

Re-employment

Retired Armed Forces Personnel of the rank of 2nd Lieutenant or equivalent and above and having experience as prescribed for deputationists. (Re-employment upto the date of superannuation with reference to civil posts.
